1. Mission-414:

As stated above, 414 polling stations across the state have been identified that had registered less than 60% voters' turnout in Lok Sabha Election-2019. The motto of Hon'ble Election Commission of India is 'No voter to be left behind', and such a low turnout is a matter of serious concern and, hence, requires targeted interventions to enhance participation of electors. Polling station specific interventions will be made in these polling stations for Lok Sabha Election-2024 in a mission mode, called Mission-414. The details of these 414 polling stations have been given in Annexure-I, for your reference.

Salient features of Mission-414:

- > "Mission 414" to be launched to increase their VTR upto the state average.
- > All 414 polling stations to be made Model Polling Stations.
- ▶ Booth Youth Icons to be appointed form among the first time voters in these polling stations.
- Awareness by apolitical and respected persons of the local areas apart from the Icons to motivate voters to participate in electoral process.
- > Special campaigns at the polling stations with the history of poll boycotts.
- > Signature walls in all such polling stations at conspicuous places under the theme "Yes, I Will Vote" to boost the enthusiasm of the voters.
- ▶ Voters across these polling stations to be given special invitation cards, prepared by the children of that area, to join the UTSAV of democracy.
- Awareness campaign to be launched through various Adventure and other Sports Associations and Operators to connect with the masses and further motivating them to participate in electoral process.
- Awareness camps to be organized at each of these polling stations to be attended by senior officers of the District i.e. DCs/ADCs, SDMs to sensitize the people about the importance of casting their vote and its direct correlation with the development of their village.
- > ELC members to make field visits and educate general public for taking ethical and mature ballot decisions and appreciate the value of their vote and sanctity of 'secrecy of vote'.
- Cultural events to be organised, based on the theme of "UTSAV", aimed at increasing voter turnout in the catchment area of these 414 polling stations.
- > Booth Awareness Groups may be activated in these polling stations.
